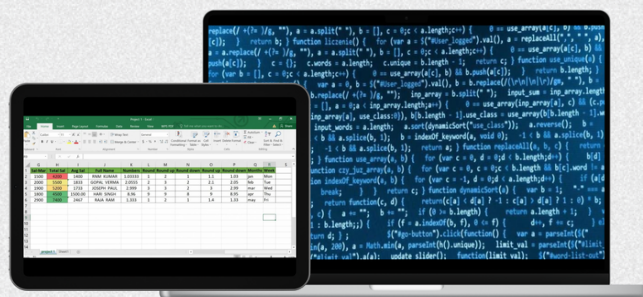

1. INTRODUCTION : WHAT IS ICDL ?

The ICDL Full standard is a **computer certification** required to do the second part of the Computer Science exam. The exams are held every week, and you can **register** from the you@b website in the section "IT certifications".

1.1 USEFUL THINGS TO KNOW

- **Who should do it?**

First year students (except BGL, BAI and BEMACS).
Students in the second year of Italian law.

- **What should I take to the exam?**

Bocconi ID (or ID: ID card, driving licence, passport)

- **The 7 modules:**

- Computer essentials
- Online essentials
- Spreadsheets
- Presentation
- IT-Security
- Word Processing
- Online Collaboration

- **When do you have to do it?**

Before the second part of Computer Science (so before May/June 2025)

>> For those who have no experience with excel, it is recommended to do the spreadsheets module after the first partial of CS



1.2 HOW TO SUBSCRIBE? ---

- **STEP 1:** Go to the YOU@B website in the widget "computer certifications": buy the skill card and 7 modules.
>> You will receive the confirmation and the code associated with your skill card on the university's Outlook email.
- **STEP 2:** click on the "IT Certifications" widget on "ICDL exam registration - exams in Bocconi"
- **STEP 3:** On first access, enter the skill card code
- **STEP 4:** Click the "Add" button and select the exams you want to register for, press "Next"
- **STEP 5:** Choose a date and time of your convenience!

2. SURVIVAL KIT

2.1 INTERNAL COST ---

18€ per module
+ 60€ skill card
= total of 186€

2.2 THINGS TO KNOW ---

- Each module **consists of 36 questions**, to **pass** the module you have to do a score equal to or greater than 75% (you can get wrong at most 9 questions).
- If you **do not pass** one of the modules, you must **buy** another module and retake it.
- You can do **up to 3 ICDL modules** at once (there is no particular order to follow)
- Each module lasts **45 minutes**, but those who finish first turn it in and leave or go to the following module if there are more

- If you take the exam **in another location**, if this location was in Italy, the certificate will be registered automatically, otherwise you must send an **email** to the B in Touch attaching the certificate.
- You can **change your registration/cancel** without paying, by doing so until 23:59 on the Thursday of the week preceding the exam date.

2.3 SUBSCRIPTION TO THE EXAM

An **email** with the certificate will arrive to each student having **passed** all seven modules, approximately one month after the last module.

3.1 HOW TO STUDY ?

3.2 WHERE TO GO ON D-DAY ?

Room 304, on the third floor of the **library** (which you can access from the stairs on the right just before passing the porches to enter the library).

WARNING : It is necessary to arrive about **15 minutes before** the beginning of the exam.

3.3 HOW TO CHECK THE RESULTS ?

AIDA website (www.aicanet.it) subscribing as "candidate" and filling the form (WITHOUT putting IT- as part of the skill card code)
